## CHART NAME: APPLICATIONS FOR IMMIGRATION BENEFITS


**WHAT IT DISPLAYS:** The below chart provides data on applications and petitions received by USCIS for immigration benefits in May 2013. This chart excludes all data associated with the citizenship related applications.

**WHAT IT SHOWS:** Immigration application receipts increased by 29 percent compared to the number received in May 2012. May 2013 approvals decreased by 7 percent, denials increased by 16 percent, and pending increased by 38% compared to May 2012.

## Applications for Benefits: Received, Approved, and Pending



- Major receipt volumes in May 2013 include: 126,355 I-765 employment authorizations; 82,097 I-130 immediate/all other petitions; 54,486 I-90 green card renewals/replacements; 50,123 I-485 applications to adjust status; 39,321 I-129 forms filed; 31,040 I-131 travel document/advance parole.
- Major volumes of pending applications at the end of May 2013 include: 825,368 I-130 immediate/all other petitions; 364,057 I-485 applications to adjust status; 272,524 I-90 green card renewals/replacements; 235,196 I-765 employment authorizations; 106,894 I-129 forms filed; 106,202 I-751 remove conditions spouse jointly/waive; 63,067 I-131 travel document/advance parole.
