- 1) FWVP Program applications are filed with the Lockbox and sent to a USCIS service center for conditional approval or denial. If conditionally approved, the case is forwarded abroad via the Department of State (DOS) National Visa Center for beneficiary interview. The beneficiary also completes a medical examination and undergoes additional security screening abroad. After completion of these steps, USCIS and DOS will either issue travel documents for the beneficiary to travel to the United States, or USCIS will deny the case.
- 2) Some petitions approved, denied, or pending may have been received in previous reporting periods.
- 3) The report reflects the most up-to-date estimate available at the time the database is queried.
- 4) Counts may differ from those reported in previous quarters due to system updates and post-adjudicative outcomes.
