CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS


WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of March 2013.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Naturalization receipts in March 2013 decreased by 19 percent when compared to March 2012, while approvals/oath increased by 9 percent and denials increased 42 percent.
