CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS


WHAT IT DISPLAYS: The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of May 2013.

WHAT IT SHOWS: Naturalization receipts in May 2013 decreased by 20 percent when compared to May 2012, while approvals/oath increased by 1 percent and denials increased 56 percent.
