## CHART NAME: NATURALIZATION BENEFITS


**WHAT IT DISPLAYS:** The below chart provides data on the Applications for Naturalization (Form N-400) received by USCIS for the month of September 2012.

**WHAT IT SHOWS:** Naturalization receipts in September 2012 increased 13 percent when compared to September 2011, while approvals/oath increased by 28 percent and denials increased 19 percent.
