Notes:

- 4) Forms Received are the number of new applications or petitions received and entered into a case-tracking system during the reporting period.
- 5) Approved are the number of applications or petitions approved during the reporting period.
- 6) Denied are the number of applications or petitions that were denied during the reporting period.
- 7) Pending is the number of applications or petitions awaiting a decision as of the end of the reporting period.

- 9) Credible and reasonable fear screenings (and their respective Forms I-867 and I-899) do not confer an immigration benefit, rather they are intended to identify individuals with viable protection claims, which are then referred to the Immigration Courts for adjudication. Asylum Officers do not adjudicate the actual asylum applications during the screening process.
- 10) Immigrant visa and Executive Office for Immigration Review adjustment, among other forms, are not included in the "Total - All Forms" line.
