



Dear U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services:

The 2012 year has been focused on careful assessment of potential projects. California Green Regional Center is attempting to find projects that comply with EB-5 investment requirements while remaining sound practical investments. CGRC has assessed many projects over the past year with most of the effort focused in the commercial real estate areas including hotels and office buildings. We are currently in the process of engaging in communication with local municipal governments such as Lancaster and the City of Los Angeles. Moreover, we have worked with local commercial real estate developers that are very familiar with the targeted areas. The 2012 year has been focused on careful assessment of potential projects.
