NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES POSTED BY ORDER OF THE EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION An Agency of the United States Government

Notice is posted pursuant to a Decision and Order by the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, dated **April 26, 2022**, which found that a violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e <u>et seq.</u> and Section 501 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, 29 U.S.C. § 791 *et seq.* has occurred within the **Agency's Potomac Service Center, Alexandria, Virginia.**

Federal law prohibits discrimination against any employee or applicant for employment because of the person's RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, DISABILITY or RETALIATION with respect to hiring, firing, promotion, compensation, or other terms, conditions or privileges of employment.

The Agency's Potomac Service Center, Alexandria, Virginia("Facility") supports and will comply with such Federal law and will not take action against employees because they have exercised their rights under law.

The Facility was found to have violated non-discrimination laws when because of an employee's disability the employee was subjected to discrimination and unlawful harassment.

The Facility has been **ORDERED** to expunge its records, pay compensatory nonpecuniary damages, to restore leave taken, to pay lost wages and to require the responsible management officials to take training in the provisions of Title VII and to post this Notice.

The Facility shall not in any manner restrain, interfere, coerce, or retaliate against any individual who exercises his or her right to oppose practices made unlawful by, or who participates in proceedings pursuant to, Federal equal employment opportunity law.
