



USCIS will trial test the following parts of the naturalization test from early June to September 2023.

- A speaking trial test
- A multiple-choice civics trial test


The trial test will have no effect on any N-400 filed by the trial participant.



- As of May 10, 170 organizations have signed up to volunteer.

- The trial test platform has two separate options.
- General English as a Second Language (ESL) programs can volunteer for the speaking trial test **only**.
- Adult citizenship programs that cover history, civics, and ESL components can volunteer for the option with **both** the speaking and civics trial test.



• TESOL has been awarded the TAG contract and facilitate the selection and onboarding of TAG members.

# **VOLUNTEERING FOR THE TRIAL TEST**





The Office of Citizenship is still seeking nonprofit organizations that are offering adult ESL classes and/or adult citizenship classes to volunteer for the trial tests. Some eligibility requirements to volunteer are listed below. Volunteer organizations must:


- Be a nonprofit with 501(c)3 status;
- Be conducting adult education classes during the trial test period; and
- Incorporate trial test educational materials provided by the Office of Citizenship in their curriculum.

Email <u>natzredesign22@uscis.dhs.gov</u>, by May 31, 2023, if you are interested in volunteering.


- Nonprofits, Community-colleges, School Districts serving adults, Libraries, are all encouraged to express interest in volunteering
- Online classes may volunteer too. Teachers will need to incorporate the educational materials just like the in-person classes.
- Again, we are still accepting volunteer organizations, but they must email <u>natzredesign22@uscis.dhs.gov</u>, by May 31, 2023. .



- Community-based organizations will receive trial test educational resources to use in their classes with volunteer trial test takers.
- Educational resources for the speaking trial test include:
  - Practice speaking test prompts.
  - Practice speaking test images on each topic.



- Educational resources for the multiple-choice civics trial test include:
  - The full bank of multiple-choice civics trial test questions and correct answer choices.
  - Civics and history handouts that outline all of the content on the multiple-choice civics trial test.
