Subject matter experts will highlight available online myUSCIS tools and demonstrate how applicants and their attorneys or representatives can file a form online. **Please note that we will not be able to answer case-specific questions.**

myUSCIS is an online service that helps users navigate the immigration process. It offers up-to-date case status information, naturalization preparation tools, and resources to help applicants determine which benefits they may be eligible for. Through myUSCIS, users can also establish an account and file several forms online.
