Service Motion on Administrative Appeals Office Decision

Form I-360, Petition for Amerasian, Widow(er), or Special Immigrant (Special Immigrant Juvenile)

The Petitioner seeks classification as a special immigrant juvenile (SIJ) under sections 101(a)(27)(J) and 204(a)(1)(G) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act), 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(27)(J) and 1154(a)(1)(G). The Director of the National Benefits Center denied the Petitioner's Form I-360, Petition for Amerasian, Widow(er), or Special Immigrant (SIJ petition), concluding that the Petitioner had not established that their SIJ petition was bona fide, and as such, USCIS' consent was not warranted. We dismissed the Petitioner's subsequent appeal. Upon further review of the record, we reopen the appeal, withdraw our prior decision, and remand to the Director to reevaluate the Petitioner's eligibility.

ORDER: The decision of the Administrative Appeals Office is withdrawn. The matter is remanded to the Director of the National Benefits Center for the entry of a new decision.
